We are set back off Leggatts Way behind leafy trees with allotments at the back surrounded by houses and housing estates. It was built in 1931 to serve the new estate (Harebreaks). It is a small building which was extended at a later date to include a hall which can be opened into the main church when capacity demands. We are a small dedicated congregation bringing the Good News of God through activities for all the family in the local communities and further afield. Our Sunday services start at 9:30am - not everyone's cup of tea on a Sunday morning!

Each year a Christmas Bazaar is held in November to raise funds for the church. This is organised and run by the members of Girl Guiding. It is well attended and enjoyed by everyone. Since 2012 our outreach project Lift Off! for families and children continues to provide opportunities for meeting up, learning about God, and having fun. Our building is also used by various community groups for their activities.
