Financially, 2023 has been a good year for our Church despite a forecast deficit at the start of the year. We are pleased to report we achieved a surplus of £50,924.41 (this follows a surplus of £8,965.33 in 2022).

This is mainly due to the generosity of our congregation and 3 legacies totalling £54,356.78. We also benefitted from the final compensation from our energy supplier for excluding us from their energy basket against our wishes. (We received £467.58 for gas, and £150 for inconvenience).

If we had not received the legacies, our expenditure would have exceeded our income by £3,432.37. For the second year running we have been saved from a deficit on our day-to-day expenditure by the generosity of legacies.

We had some further repairs to the church roof in 2023 which were paid from the Lowery fund.

We are extremely fortunate to retain a strong financial position. Some of our financial assets are for restricted purposes and the PCC maintains the policy that these monies, built up over many years, should be retained for long term capital works to protect and enhance our beautiful church building. In 2023, the PCC decided that the residual of the legacies received from Anne Calvert, Joan Stables and Hilary Kilby, would be invested in a Benefactors Fund to provide income to help the running of the church.

Our main expenditure continued to be the Ministry Offer. The PCC remains committed to support our local ministry and those churches within the Diocese less well off than ourselves.

The church maintains its policy on reserves: It is the policy of St Mark's Church to keep unrestricted reserves based on four months normal expenditure to cover unforeseen emergencies and to maintain a healthy cash flow. This policy is reviewed annually.

Some of you may have heard in the press that we received a "grant" from the government of £4,212.25. This was in fact the VAT on the lighting project which we were allowed to reclaim. This money was received in 2022 and was included in last year's accounts (see page 3).

Thank you to everyone for your continued financial support.

### Independent Examiner's Report to the Parochial Church Council

I report on the accounts of the church for the year ended 31st December 2023, which are set out on pages one to six.

### Respective Responsibilities of the PCC and the Examiner.

The Church's PCC is responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The Church's PCC consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.
