Revision of Church Electoral Roll

Notice is hereby given that the Church Electoral Roll of St George's, Wrotham will be revised by the Parochial Church Council (PCC), beginning on the 13th April 2024 and ending on 4th May 2024. In order for a person to be entitled to attend the Annual Parochial Church meeting (APCM) on Sunday, 19th May and to take part in its proceedings, an Application Form for Enrolment must be returned by the date shown above for the ending of the revision of the Church Electoral Roll by the PCC.
