# **OTHER NEWS FROM ACROSS THE WEST WIGHT MISSION COMMUNITY**

#### FROM TOM JACKSON at Christ Church

From April 1st the BBC Daily Service will cease to be available on long wave radio. It's moving to the digital radio station BBC Radio 4 Extra, which can be found not only on digital radios but also on Freeview televisions as channel 708. It will therefore be much easier to access than it was before. If you have a digital recorder you may be able to record it, and even to set up a series recording, although at the time of writing I am not able to check this.

The Daily Service is an act of worship which the BBC broadcasts between 9.45am and 10am on weekdays. The format varies considerably from day to day, but includes a bible reading, teaching or reflection, prayers and music. If you are a new listener and don't find the first service particularly suitable for you, do give it time. Over the years I have found many services to be a source of great comfort or enlightenment, and others to be very challenging!
