Using your gifts for God. Do you ever wonder if you could use your gifts, skills and wisdom in a different way? Funding: Did you know that if church members raised their personal giving each year by the rate of inflation, average giving in each parish since 2020 would have increased by over 50%? Every year we ask you to review your regular giving: supporting the local church is a bible-based expression of discipleship. Times are still hard, we know, but can you afford to increase your giving or start a regular donation for the first time?
