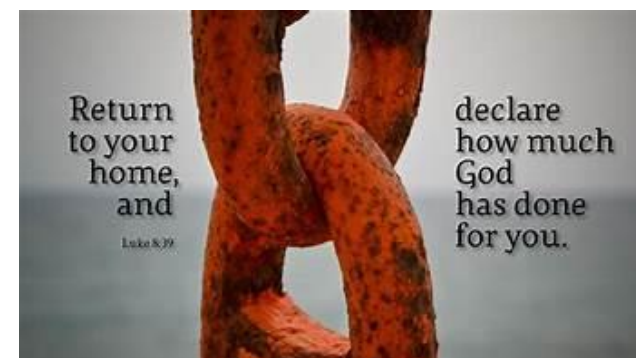

It is easy to despair about the state of

not armies, or at least not human
aggressors and is very dramatic. It
focusses on some of the fallout from

one person who he heals in an
amazing way.

Jesus is still concerned with those who
are in spiritual turmoil and enduring
mental struggles. Pray for them to find
the same peace, hope and a
transformed future that Luke
describes.
