Parish Ride and Stride Organiser needed URGENTLY

Unfortunately, due to illness, Arline Stovell has had to give up the role of Ride and Stride organiser for Christ Church with St Mary's.

Ride and Stride is organised by the Wiltshire Historic Churches Trust, to raise funds by sponsorship, for repairs to historic churches. Half of the sponsorship money is returned to the parish, so is a good fundraiser for our churches too. The job is not difficult or time consuming. It entails booking the event with Chris in the community centre office, organising a rota of volunteers to welcome people to Christ Church and St Mary's who are riding and striding for the annual event, always on the second Saturday in September between 10 am and 6 pm. You also need to advertise for people to walk or cycle from the parish to as many churches as possible, about 3 months before the event, which this year is on Saturday 13 September.

All information is available on the Wiltshire Historic Churches Trust web site, including sponsor forms, publicity material etc.

The new person will need to register the churches with Keith Rayward, Wiltshire organiser soon, and show what facilities you can offer (toilets and refreshments). It is also a good idea to liaise with Bath Road and Immanuel in the ecumenical parish to make sure if they have registered. After the event sponsorship forms and cheques need to be collected in and forwarded to Keith Rayward. Luckily most people now get sponsorship on Just Giving. You just have to make sure that the totals add up!

Arline has laminated signs etc which she will pass on, together with any help that she is able to give.

Please contact Carol in the Parish Office if you can take on this small but important fundraising job.
