

Haven in Romania, Charity No.105136 - rep: Maggie Wilson

Founded in 1991 by Frinton Christians, this charity partners with the Baptist Church in Piatra Neamt, Romania. Over its many years it has built strong relationships with local orphanages in and around the area, employing Romanians in ministries it founded. We help support the *Silvia Centre* which

focuses on children with additional needs (not provided by the state). As well as financial and prayer support, over the years Dr Maggie Wilson and various other members of St Mary's have spent many weeks encouraging and training the Romanian staff to a high professional level, making the world of difference to so many lives.



London City Mission, Charity No. 247186 - rep: Lesley Holland

LCM shares the Gospel alongside Christians in local churches in London, equipping them to bring the message of hope in Christ to those least likely to hear it. Historically, St Mary's donated toys at Christmas for children in families known by LCM, but now emphasis has changed to reaching the most marginalised, particularly the homeless. We support the Webber Street Day Centre, close to Waterloo Station, visited by around 70 homeless guests,

primarily men, each day. This Christmas we will donate financially towards this work. Also, good quality second-hand men's clothes, suitable for the homeless, would be appreciated. More details in the autumn.

When we look at the MENA (the Middle East and North Africa) today, it can be hard to know how to pray, yet these are the lands that fill the pages of our Bibles, where Jesus walked and the Church itself was born. SAT-7 broadcasts the good news about Jesus, and how to follow him, right across these countries and far beyond. Broadcasts are 24/7, in

Arabic, Persian, and Turkish, to children, youth, women, men and families, with content which is educational, and provides Christian teaching and entertainment. SAT-7 also provides a support service for viewers who contact them for advice or prayer. **PRAYER DIARIES** for July to September have arrived and are at the back and front of church. Please take one (or ask Heather for one) to help you pray for the Middle East.
