YOU'RE INVITED TO JOIN CHURCHSUITE

St Mark's & St Andrew's are now set up to use ChurchSuite (an online church management tool) that will enable access to the church calendar, rota and an address book.

To begin with we are inviting everyone to join the address book which replaces the church directory. The benefit is that each person can manage their own contact details and make their own updates, as well as decide which details you want to be visible to others.

- In the next few days you should receive an email inviting you to join My ChurchSuite.
- You will be asked to click on a button and then set a password.
- Once you have logged in, you will be able to manage your contact details, making updates where necessary.

Download the app - download the ChurchSuite app for your device and then you can access it from your phone/tablet. (it is also accessible from a PC)

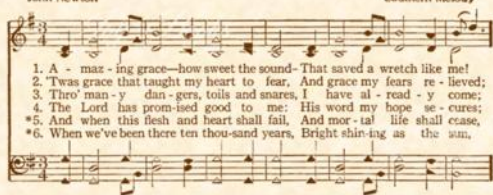

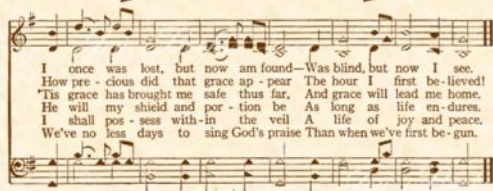
Amazing Grace
