Time of refreshment... - Rachel Cramp LLM

It is so important to take a time of refreshment, for lots of us that means days out or a holiday, but it can mean a time of 'refreshing and Spiritual renewal'.

For me, for many years that has meant a trip north to Northumberland and either retreats or holidays on the Holy Island of Lindisfarne. Only today someone said to me that it isn't really an island, and it isn't quite, with the causeway being open for two periods of time a day, at low tide, but it is wonderful to sit and watch the sea roll in, across the low lying land, to hear it lap across the road, as it turns Lindisfarne into an island. It turns it from a busy area, full of cars, coaches and tourists back into a tranquil island, and returns it to the islanders and those of us lucky enough to be temporary residents.

But it is so much more that just a glorious island, with sea birds and seals and many different beaches: the incredible empty expanse of sand, that is the North Beach; the pebbly beaches overlooking Bamburgh and the Farne Islands, and the beach south of St Mary's Church, overlooking Saint Cuthbert's own island - it is a thin place where we can feel especially close to heaven, experiencing the peace and presence of Jesus in a special way.

'The Celtic saints often referred to somewhere as a "thin place". This referred to when the spiritual atmosphere of a location made it easy to connect with God, almost as though there is no barrier between heaven and earth... These places still exist and people hungry to encounter the living God will actively seek them out. We might call it a pilgrimage and some places are obvious like Iona in Scotland, or Holy Island in Northumberland.'

When we drive onto Holy Island, a calming of the mind descends, even if it is still busy! And there is never a pull to go for trips off the Island, sitting watching the rhythm of the tide come and go, walking around the island, taking time, and listening to God, is all we need.

But perhaps your 'thin' place is closer to home, a place where you can still your mind, and listen to what God is saying to you. Often those places are close to nature, by a river, under a special tree or just in your garden, but wherever it is, do take time this summer to rest and refresh, time for yourself and time for God.
