Today's (27th July) Collect prays that God, as if drawing from a huge reservoir of grace, will 'pour into our hearts' such love towards him that we will love him 'above all things'. What that means, as Jesus explained, is to love God 'with all your heart (*commitment*), with all your soul (*longing*), with all your mind (*thinking*), and with all your strength (*serving*)', and to love your neighbour as yourself. God is addressed, in today's (3rd August) Collect, as 'the author and giver of all good things'. This reminds us that the world exists, not because of mere chance, but because God planned and created it in the beginning. We gather together here to celebrate the gifts of creation and redemption, asking God to 'graft in our hearts the love of your name'.

- Help the elderly lead dignified, secure and healthy lives


