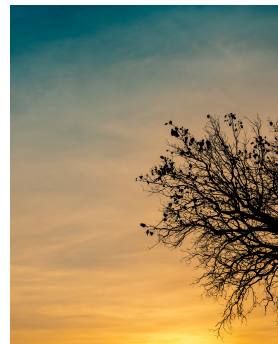

News from our four Churches...

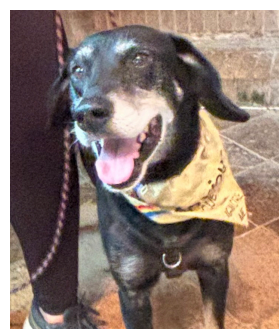
ALL ARE WELCOME TO NATASHA'S GRAVE TALK THIS SATURDAY:

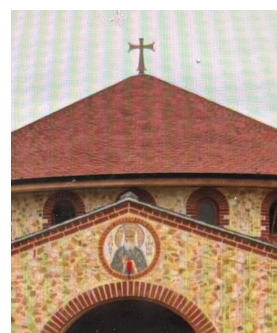

Come and join us for this family friendly pet service held in the Churchyard (if nice weather!). All pets are welcome and refreshments for both humans (and pets!) will be served after the service.

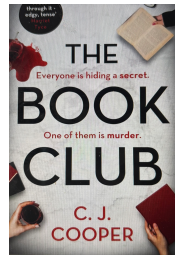


OUR VISIT TO THE MONASTERY OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST BY ROBERT LINES
