## BIG BUTTERFLY COUNT – THE COUNTDOWN IS ON!

**18<sup>TH</sup> July to 10<sup>th</sup> August 2025**

The big butterfly count is a nationwide survey aimed at helping assess the health of our environment. Simply count butterflies for 15 minutes during bright (preferably sunny) weather sometime between 18<sup>th</sup> July and 10<sup>th</sup> August. Record what species you see, using the identification sheet provided with the notices or in church, and how many there are. You can send in your sightings online at [www.bigbutterflycount.org](http://www.bigbutterflycount.org), or you can download a mobile app.

### **Why take part?**

- 1. Keep up your butterfly identification knowledge** with the refreshed ID guides.
- 2. Contribute to citizen science** and represent butterflies in your local area.
- 3. Spend quality time outdoors** with your family and friends.
- 4. Improve your mental health & wellbeing.**
