Today's readings are Luke 10: 25-37 and Colossians 1: 1-14

Keith writes...

In the story of the Good Samaritan the outsider provides a better example of the love of neighbour than the representatives of Jewish orthodoxy. The lawyer whose question prompts Jesus to tell the parable seeks a definition: who qualifies as my neighbour? Jesus provides an example which makes it clear that the act of being a neighbour is more important than debating who one should be a neighbour to. The implication is that we should be a neighbour to whoever we meet that needs it – That, in fact, is all the definition required. It is a preference for love over law.

Part of the purpose of this piece of scripture is to continue Jesus' challenge to his Jewish audience to consider what it really means to be the people of God. He offers Israel a vision of God's Kingdom, based on love, which is largely rejected in the end. After the birth of the church, the followers of Jesus concluded that the people of God could no longer be defined by ethnicity, nor by the adoption of particular religious customs but by faith in Christ and commitment to the priority of love. That is still what should define us and our vision of the world. I wonder what the implications of this might be for the migrant crisis which so much exercises the minds of the government, the media, and, apparently, very many British people?
