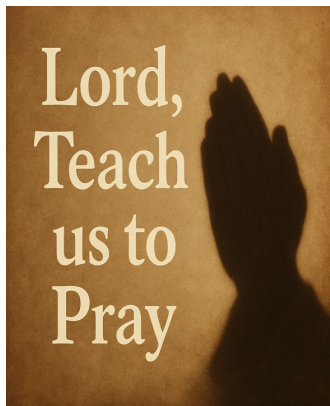

Over 2,500 children and young people have booked and will have the opportunity to make great friends, take part in incredible

activities, and explore life with Jesus.

Please join me in praying that every child going will have great fun, make connections, be kept safe, and move forward with Jesus. **Pray too** for the Overall Leaders and their teams to have immense energy and manage any challenges with wisdom. These holidays are usually about a week long and offer a wide range of activities, games, sports, and crafts, as well as interactive sessions where the Christian faith is explored in a relevant way through worship, talks, Bible study, and drama.

In particular please pray for *Danehill Ventures: Young Leadership*, 27 - 29 July; *Summer 2*, 30 July - 6 August; *Summer 3*, 7 - 14 August; and *Summer 4*, 15 - 22 August (with Daniel Ursell helping throughout the summer) and then, *Autumn*, in half-term, 27 - 30 October (when I will be helping, and Chimbi from St Mary's will also be going).
