Grace Will Lead Me Home - 15th October from 7pm at Croydon Minster: A powerful and timely exploration of John Newton's life and his iconic hymn, "Amazing Grace", on the occasion of his 300th birthday. This special event delves into the link between the beloved song and the slave trade, its enduring status as a protest against oppression, and its profound relevance to today's legacies of colonialism. This performance weaves together traditionally inspired and new songs, interwoven with poignant excerpts from 18th-century diaries and writings by figures like Newton, Wilberforce, and Equiano.
