#### The Service of God

In our Gospel reading for this Sunday Luke 10.38-42 Jesus visits the home of Martha and her sister Mary. Mary finds time to sit and listen to Jesus, but Martha is too busy with her chores. Martha grumbles about the lack of help from her sister, but Jesus suggests that, right now, listening to what he has to say is the most important thing to be done.

It reminds us that Service to God must be wholehearted, not grudging or resentful. And that there are many ways of serving God and everyone has an important contribution to make among other things - how do you respond to this reading?
