Carole, our Associate Priest, works for Sailors' Society and she will be leading this special Benefice Service at 11.00am at Powerstock.

This will be a child-friendly Eucharist where you can hear about the Society's Crisis Response Network and real-life case studies from the 10 years this support system has been in place.

At its centre, the service will use Matthew 14: 24-33 and the theme of 'being there when a storm hits.'

The whole service will have a maritime theme, so feel free to dress up and bring something that reminds you of the sea to decorate the church.

Carole will also be bringing some 'fishy' nibbles to help us carry on the celebration after the main service.



Free entry and parking.


Dogs welcome. Proceeds from light refreshments will go towards funding the Dementia exercise class at Bridport Leisure Centre.


