#### **Confirmation Classes**

#### Adults – 17<sup>th</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> Sept, 1<sup>st</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Oct at 7.30pm Young People (aged 12+) – 28<sup>th</sup> Sept, 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> Oct at 2pm

In the autumn Rev'd Rosheen will be running some Confirmation Classes open to all the 5 churches. There will be a Confirmation Service at Truro Cathedral on 25<sup>th</sup> October for those who wish to go ahead and be confirmed. Please be praying for those who might take this step.

#### Who is it for?

Anyone who has been baptised, often as a child, can be confirmed as an adult. Speak to Rev'd Rosheen if you have any questions or are interested to know more. If you would simply like to explore your faith you are welcome to attend, there is no pressure to be confirmed at the end of these sessions.

#### Why get confirmed?

When someone gets confirmed it is an opportunity to declare before the bishop, your friends and family and church community what you believe. The bishop will ask you to 'confirm' the promises made at your baptism and pray for you to receive the Holy Spirit to give you the strength to live God's way for the rest of your life. It is a wonderful step in the Christian journey.


