## Vision - Rev Sarah

As two churches together, we began looking at who we are and what our vision for the future might be earlier this year. We had a PCC away day together and explored the topic in some depth! Well, now we want your input too! St George's & Claines are your churches and it's so important that your voice is heard.

I've come from a background where the church I've been part has always had a vision, and it's revisited every few years. But it's not something that all churches have always done, and many still don't. I believe it's really important that we have a vision as churches together, and I believe it's a biblical principle too. Proverbs 29:18 says "Where there is no vision, the people perish" and look at just how many times Jesus tells his followers what the kingdom is like, what his Father is like and what following him is like! Jesus is always giving vision for the future. When we have a vision, it helps to give us direction in where we spend money, what groups we run, how we engage with the local community and the projects we get involved in. Setting our vision has to be a prayerful task and needs to involve the whole church community, so I'm asking you where do you want to see our two churches focus their energy? Please be praying about this and bring your thoughts to one of our Vision Sundays.

We will have a Sunday at each church that is particularly focused around this, and they will be surrounded in prayer! There will be the 6 prayer stations that focus on key areas of church life; mission, children, youth and families engagement, community, working together, inclusivity and projects. You'll have time to engage with the stations and to pray for the work happening before filling in a short vision questionnaire.
