## \*IMPORTANT NOTICE\* – NATIONAL TEST of the EMERGENCY ALERT SYSTEM On SUNDAY 7<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER at 3.00 pm

Some of you may already know that the UK Government will be conducting a national test of the Emergency Alert system on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September at 3.00 pm. During this test, mobile phones may emit a loud alert sound and display a message, even if on silent. This is part of a nationwide initiative to ensure the alert system is functioning correctly in case of future emergencies. Please be aware of this, especially if you're working or attending any events at that time.
