Visit of the Revd's. Guy and Ruth Donegan-Cross It was a real joy to have Guy preaching at Christ Church on 20<sup>th</sup> July and we are grateful to him for really

opening up what is means to be a Disciple of Jesus today. Guy was selling his two excellent books 'Discipleship: Start this Way, and 'Discipleship: Walk this Way'. Many members of the congregation bought copies of these books at the reduced rate from Guy and we shall be using them in the coming months. The questions which it addresses are as follows:
