Visit of the Revd's. Guy and Ruth Donegan-Cross It was a real joy to have Guy preaching at Christ Church on 20th July and we are grateful to him for really opening up what is means to be a Disciple of Jesus today. Guy was selling his two excellent books 'Discipleship: Start this Way, and 'Discipleship: Walk this Way'. Many members of the congregation bought copies of these books at the reduced rate from Guy and we shall be using them in the coming months. The questions which it addresses are as follows:

- Who is helping me grow as a disciple?
- Who am I helping to grow?

God grows the church. We join in with his mission. But our task is Matthew 28: 'go and make disciples of all nations...'.

'The best way to grow the church is to grow people'. 'We have seen it happen over and over. The presence of a significant number of disciples changes everything: a parish's spiritual tone, energy level, attendance, bottom line and what parishioners ask of the leaders, Disciples pray with passion, Disciples worship. Disciples love the church and serve her with energy and joy. Disciples give lavishly... Disciples care about the poor and bring about justice. Disciples take risks for the Kingdom of God'.
