News:

• PARISH PROFILE

The Profile Team are hard at work preparing the submission of paperwork with regard to the welcoming of a new Vicar to serve alongside us at the Minster and Whitelackington. Our next step will be completion of the profile, proof reading, and approval by the PCC prior to forwarding to Archdeacon Simon for his input and approval.

• PCC MEETING - PEWSHEET SUMMARY

Electoral Roll members may request a full copy of the minutes once approved.

The PCC met on 21 July 2025. Subject to the approval of the minutes, the PCC discussed and agreed on the following. This is a summary of that meeting.

Safeguarding - We spent time reviewing the Safeguarding Action Plan. We are on level 3, which is a great place to be. The Kiosk project has its own section, and non-church activities in the Minster Rooms have an updated hiring agreement. The Church hiring agreement will be reviewed. Ideas were shared to ensure we promote the welfare of vulnerable groups, and a working party will consider this further. It was suggested that we celebrate when someone completes their Safeguarding levels.

Finance Report - Income is forecast to be £21K higher than the budget, due to one-off donations from parishioners and a legacy payment. Without these, we would have been under budget by £4,000. We are now forecasting a surplus of £6,216 compared to a budget deficit of £14,913. The PCC thanked Carol for this report.

The Well - Natalie gave the PCC an update on this project. The PCC agreed on the name of The Well. It is hoped to be open this week, and she has received £5,000 from the Diocese. A steering group has been set up. Natalie is speaking to the council about security.

Defibrillator - We have received a grant for this and are seeking planning permission for its installation on the wall of the Minster Rooms.
