Christ Church Swindon Wins Eco Church Gold Award Christ Church Swindon has become the first church in Swindon to receive the prestigious A Rocha UK Eco Church Gold Award, becoming the 111th church nationwide and third in the Diocese of

Bristol recognised for outstanding creation care. The award follows years of work by the church's Eco Team, led by Anne Grainger, who said: "We are very happy to receive this award as it shows we are moving in the right direction; this is not the finish line but a milestone on our journey to help protect the earth for future generations, and to inspire others to do the same." The Rt Revd Neil Warwick, Bishop of Swindon, praised the achievement as "a wonderful example of how our church communities are responding to the cry of the earth."


