Dear Friends,

Finding time and space for silence can be very difficult. The world in which we live prioritises activity, noise, speed, and haste over stillness and recollection. Portsmouth can be an exciting and energising place, but it is also one in which many voices via for our attention. Amidst these sources of distraction, our churches offer a point of stillness in which we are able to find calm, hear the voice of the Lord, and reconnect with our own inner world. This is one of the reasons why keeping our churches at the centre of our community is so important. The number of visitors who find our churches by chance and come in to spend a few moments in prayer, to spiritually catch their breath, or light a candle, is astounding. I pray that the beauty of our buildings and the peace to be found inside is something that speaks to visitors of God's presence and of his love for them. To extend the opportunities for people to find our churches open the PCC have recently agreed to open our churches in the afternoon on Thursdays at The Ascension and Fridays at St Saviour, to include a sign outside encouraging people to come in and see what is inside, this will also be an ideal time to arrange weddings and baptisms etc

Many of our parishioners also find that attending one of our weekday Masses offers a time for recollection and quiet. The Low Masses offered on weekdays are an opportunity to reconnect with the Lord present in Word and Sacrament. It is a good way of punctuating our busy days with a moment of peace and calm as we seek to refocus and reorientate our lives to what is really important. A reminder that there is no Friday evening Mass during August (or December).

August itself is a quiet month with less going on, but there are three important occasions to be aware of:

Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> August is the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord and also marks the 7<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of my installation here as Priest-in-Charge, which worryingly makes me one of the longer serving vicars here! We will celebrate with a Sung Mass at St Saviour at 11.30am, followed by drinks and nibbles.

The 15<sup>th</sup> August is The Feast of The Assumption, when we celebrate the end of Our Lady's life on earth as she was taken up into heaven. On the eve there will be Solemn Evensong at The Ascension at 7pm. On the day itself, Friday 15th we are invited to join with St Mary's Portsea for their Patronal Festival at 7pm where the preacher will be The Archdeacon of the Meon. Most importantly on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> our new Bishop hosts a Richborough Festival at Portsmouth Cathedral, beginning with Mass at noon, please do make every effort to attend.

Finally it has been a great joy to have Kerensa Matthews here with us on placement as our Pastoral Assistant for the past year. Kerensa's final service with us will be Evensong at The Ascension at 6pm on Sunday 31st August and I'm sure you will all wish to be present on that occasion to send her off with our best wishes. Luke our Bishop will be in attendance and will be giving Benediction. We will be taking a leaving collection for Kerensa, any donations would be gratefully received by Neville Reed or Elizabeth Weitzmann.
