This year we remember St Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist either on Sunday 21st or Monday 22nd September. Matthew (also known as Levi) was a tax-collector for the detested occupying Romans. He was called by Christ to be one of the Twelve apostles despite his dubious background. Matthew followed his Lord faithfully until he was martyred, either in Ethiopia or in Persia. It is in Matthew's gospel that we are given the genealogy of Jesus. Matthew is the patron saint of accountants, bankers and tax-collectors.
