A lot of children and their families have had a very anxious few weeks. The GCSE exam results came out on Thursday 21st August and emotions for those waiting have been all over the place, as students opened that all important envelope. It has been particularly difficult for this year's students as they had their studies interrupted by Covid 19. This virus profoundly affected school pupils through significant learning deficits, with a significant impact on their physical and mental health. School closures led to widespread loss of learning and a shift to online learning which exposed disparities in access to devices, internet connectivity and digital literacy, creating barriers to some students. Psychological effects on children in the UK have been listed as boredom, loneliness and frustration. Irritability, restlessness, anxiety and arguing with the rest of the family were also reported as manifesting during this period. Any exam situation is tough enough but it is the first major step, well not a step, a stride towards the future. A future that holds many opportunities if you choose to take them. However, learning is not confined to childhood or formal education but is an ongoing journey. Individuals can choose what, when, and how they learn based on their own interests and goals. Pursuing interests and passions enrich life, fosters curiosity and leads to a deeper understanding of the world.
