Would anyone be interested in becoming a Church First Aider? There is a course in Salford running in the autumn which church is willing to fund for anyone who might be interested. We are hoping in the next week or two to have a defibrillator fitted to the outside wall of the Choir Vestry – visible from the bus stop. The defibrillator will have full instructions on how to use it in the housing but a successful outcome of its use relies on someone administering CPR until the machine is located and ready to be deployed. It seems right, therefore, to encourage one or two people in church to be trained in first aid.
