
New walkers will be really welcome!

#### Link to the Walk:

- 1. We start at St Helen's Crematorium. We have time to look around /walk around to see the various graves, ruins and other points of interest.
- 2. We then go over the Abbey Rd bridge over the A580.
- 3. From here past Windle Hall, across the fields back to Crank Rd.
- 4. From Crank Rd back to the Rainford By Pass.
- 5. Crossing over the A570/ A580 junction we head back to the Crematorium
