And finally...Happy Birthday the Crisp, on 24th August 1853 George Crum, a chef at Moon's Lake House restaurant in Saratoga Springs, New York, was asked by a customer, Cornelius Vanderbilt, for thinner slices of fried potatoes, leading Crum to create exceptionally thin, crisp slices of potato. The "crisps" rapidly became very popular. In the UK an average of 20 million packets are eaten per day.
