The Way Forward Update

Phase one building work on site commenced Monday 30th June and takes 12 weeks to complete. This will include internal renovations, building of the mezzanine, installation of the kitchen and servery, creation of storage space, a new heating system and redecoration of the internal building. The organ will be reinstalled in its new location and we will be back in Church before Christmas although the organ will not be playable until the New Year as it takes some time to settle before final tuning can take place.

While this initial phase is ongoing, we continue to raise funds to complete phase two. There are several grant applications in progress which we will hear results from in the coming months. Should funding be complete we will run the phase two external build concurrently and I will update you on progress as it happens. Whilst we have made significant progress on our internal fundraising target of £200k there is still some way to go and your continued support is appreciated.

I am sure you will agree this is an exciting time for St John's and your patience and support as we move through this phase of upheaval is greatly appreciated. As always if you have any questions, please ask a member of The Way Forward Group.

As a reminder, there is NO ACCESS to the main church building by anyone throughout the building works. The vestry is accessible from outside and keys have been allocated to those who require them for service set up. Please speak to Angela or Sarah if you have any questions regarding this.
