Genesis 15:1-6 Psalm 33:12-22	Hebrews 11:1-3,8-16	Luke 12:32-40
The Lord visits Abram in a vision, promising despite his protestations that, although he is childless, his descendants will be innumerable. Finally, Abram believes.	In faith Abraham obeyed God, even though he and Sarah wouldn't live to see God's promises fulfilled. The reference to "all of these" who "died in faith" is about Abel, Enoch and Noah. They were, as we are, "strangers and foreigners on the earth". Our true home is our heavenly home.	Words of comfort and assurance that God wants to give us the kingdom are followed by an exhortation to live simply and charitably, relying on heavenly rather than earthly treasure. Jesus likens faithful people to slaves waiting for their master to return from a wedding. Those who wait in a state of watchful preparedness will be rewarded.

Isaiah speaks of future hope – the rebuilding of what is destroyed and the nourishing of land that is parched – but it is linked to a command to live justly, humbly and mercifully.	God is a consuming fire – we are right to be terrified, but through the grace that is ours through Christ, we can come safely to him, taking our place among God's people in the heavenly city.	On the sabbath, in the synagogue, Jesus heals a woman from an ailment that has afflicted her for eighteen years. The crowds are delighted; the religious leaders are angered.

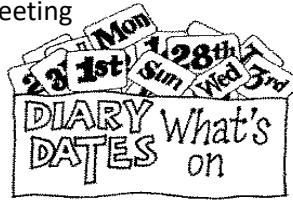
