PROPOSED CHANGES TO FREE PARKING ON SUNDAYS – HAVE YOUR SAY!

Wakefield Council have issued a notice of intent (dated 17 July 2025) to bring in a new traffic order to rescind all off street parking, which is currently free on Sundays, and introduce Sunday charging for car parks from 08:00 to 18:00 in Pontefract.

We strongly urge you to object to this proposed Order as it will impact the majority of our congregation.
