Next walk on *Saturday 9th August* will be a leisurely circular stroll approximately 4½ - 5 miles in length. Meet on pavement outside the vicarage at 10.30am, for car share travel to start/finish point in Rothwell. We will explore various gentle uphill tracks through Rothwell Country Park, then follow the Pickpocket Lane path to Holmsley Lane & Church Street, Woodlesford, where we'll stop for food and drink at the *Two Pointers* pub. (Info on menu options available at www.twopointers.co.uk) Afterwards we'll continue down Pottery Lane to pick up the Aire & Calder Canal towpath at Woodlesford Lock. After

approx a mile we turn into the Country Park for a short uphill path to the cars.
