Simon and Jude have been remembered together by the Church on 28 October since the 7th century.

They are among the 12 apostles chosen by Jesus. Simon is known as the 'Zealot' because he is thought to have been involved in opposing the occupying Romans. Jude is also known as Thaddaeus and a New Testament letter bears his name. He is not to be confused with Judas Iscariot. It is said that that Simon and Jude preached the Gospel in Persia where both were martyred. Jude is the patron saint of lost causes while Simon is the patron saint of sawyers and tanners.
