Genesis 28: 10-17 ¹⁰Jacob left Beersheba and started towards Haran. ¹¹At sunset he came to a holy place and camped there. He lay down to sleep, resting his head on a stone. ¹²He dreamt he saw a stairway reaching from earth to heaven, with angels going up and coming down. ¹³And there was the LORD standing beside him. "I am the Lord, the God of Abraham and Isaac," he said "I will give to you and your descendants this land on which you are lying. ¹⁴They will be as numerous as specks of dust on the earth. They will extend their territory in all directions and through you and your descendants I will bless all the nations. ¹⁵Remember, I will be with you and protect you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land. I will not leave you until I have done all that I promised you." ¹⁶Jacob woke up and said, "The LORD is here! He is in this place, and I didn't know it!" ¹⁷He was afraid and said, "What a terrifying place this is! It must be the house of God; it must be the gate that opens into heaven."

Revelations 12: 7-12 War broke out in heaven: Michael & his angels fought with the Dragon & the dragon and his angels fought, ⁸but they did not prevail, nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer. ⁹So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil & Satan who deceives the whole world; he was cast to earth & his angels were cast out with him. ¹⁰Then I heard a voice saying in heaven "Now salvation & strength, & the kingdom of God and the power of Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before God day & night, has been cast down. 11And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb & the word of their testimony & they did not love their lives to the death. 12 Therefore rejoice, O Heavens, & you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth & the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wealth, because he knows he has a short time."

John 1: 47-end When Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him, he said of him, "Here is truly an Israelite in whom there is no deceit!" 48Nathanael asked him, "Where did you get to know me?" Jesus answered, "I saw you under the fig tree before Philip called you." 49 Nathanael replied, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!" 50 Jesus answered, "Do you believe because I told you that I saw you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than these." 51 And he said to him, "Very truly, I tell you, you will see heaven and earth opened and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man."
