It is a charity that helps to feed children in South Africa. In Malawi, Mozambique, Zambia and Zimbabwe, they are currently reaching 1.5 MILLION children in the region with nutritious school meals. However, there are an estimated **21 million children** in the region suffering from malnutrition.
