In line with their twin themes, they shall be reminding visitors of the importance of buying fairtrade whilst any donations received will be sent to Ramallah Friends School, a Quaker school situated in the West Bank of Palestine, and now under constant threat of being surrounded by IDF incursions into the area.

### TIME AND TALENTS

This requires volunteers to arrive at church 30 minutes before the start of the communion service, and duties include:

- Preparing the wafers, wine and water
- Setting up the 'credence' table
- Putting the candles out & ensuring they are lit
- Laying the Altar
- Returning everything to the Vestry, washing & drying them.

#### Server

This requires volunteers to arrive at church 10-15 minutes before the start of the communion service, and duties include:

- Robing
- Assisting the priest in laying the Altar during the service
- Assisting the priest in clearing the Altar after communion
