The council propose to build new homes on both Court Ash & North Lane car parks which will greatly affect our church family and all the events that happen at St. John's. The council are expected to publish further details about the consultation in the coming weeks, including its length, how the public can participate and any public drop-in events which are planned. Once the consultation is complete, it is due back before the planning and transport policy sub-committee for approval, possibly before Christmas.
