

All: It is right to give thanks and praise.


Almighty God, whose Son Jesus Christ was baptised in the River Jordan, we thank you for the gift of water to cleanse and revive us.

We thank you that through the waters of the Red Sea you led your people out of slavery to freedom in the Promised Land.


We thank you that through the deep waters of death you brought your Son and raised him to life triumph.




Bless this water, that your servants who are washed in it may be made one with Christ in his death and in his resurrection, to be cleansed and delivered from all sin.

Alex, is this your faith?


This is my faith




