

Time for Reflection

This week's readings are

Colossians 1.15-20

John 14.6-11



In this passage, Jesus tells His disciples: "I am the way, the truth, and the life." These words are both comforting and challenging. They remind us that following Jesus is not just about rules or religion – it is about relationship. He doesn't simply point us toward God; He is the path that leads us to the Father.

When Phillip asked to see the Father, Jesus gently explained that to know Him is to know God. Everything Jesus said and did-His love, His compassion, His teaching, His miracles-revealed the heart of God. Sometimes we may long for clearer proof of God's presence, but Jesus reminds us that we already have all we need when we look to Him.

This passage invites us to deepen our trust. Jesus is the way when we feel lost, the truth when we are unsure, and the life when we feel weary. He draws us close to God and fills us with hope and strength.
