#### REFLECTIONS......REV. BEA ERSKINE

As we walked out across a stubble field, up popped a hare and hopped away through the hedge in front of us, followed by a group of deer with their magnificent leaps, bounding over the same hedge and across the field with their coats shining in the first light of morning. It was absolutely breathtakingly beautiful. God's glorious creation in all its extraordinary magnificence. While walking I was thinking about the harvest this year and how with a very dry summer, it has been quite a worry for farmers that there won't be enough fodder grown for livestock, to last the winter. But of course, we have now had rain and the grass is growing fast.
