did not regard equality with God

may have eternal life.
¹⁶ 'For God so loved the world that he
gave his only Son, so that everyone who
believes in him may not perish but may
have eternal life.
¹⁷ 'Indeed, God did not send the Son into
the world to condemn the world, but in
order that the world might be saved
through him.
