Some church terminology

St John's Golcar and St Mark's Longwood are **parish churches,** serving their parishes (areas around the church).

The vicar doesn't just take services, and they are not just there for the congregations, but they do things for the whole of the parishes.

Did you know, everyone in England has a Church of England parish church, and can come to services there?

Our two parishes are joined together to form a "Benefice". This means they share a vicar and find ways to work together and support each other.

A group of benefices join together to form a "**Deanery**". We are in the Huddersfield Deanery, which stretches from Marsden to Bradley.

A group of deaneries forms the **Episcopal Area**. 'Episcopal' means we have a bishop. We are in the Huddersfield Episcopal Area, Smitha Prasadam is the Area Bishop of Huddersfield.

We are in the **diocese** of Leeds; our bishop is Nick Baines (soon to retire). Our diocese consists of 5 areas.

We are in the Northern **Province** of the Church of England, our provincial bishop is the **Archbishop of York**, Stephen Cottrell.

The **Archbishop of Canterbury** is the lead bishop of all the Church of England. This post is currently vacant.

We are part of **The Body of Christ**, which is all Christians throughout the world!
