Our Self Worth

A sense of self worth is a wonderful gift and despite all the advances of modern society it is something that seems to be more and more in short supply. There are many things that promote our sense of self worth including our achievements, which may well include a fulfilling job and also when we are thought well of and are loved by others. These of course are valid, but I want to share with you two others.

First, as the Psalmist has it (Psalm 139) we are 'fearfully and wonderfully made'. How are bodies work is miraculous in their huge complexity and beauty and any problems we experience beyond those that are self-inflicted are related to our ancestors, Adam and Eve becoming estranged from our loving heavenly Father which resulted in death and its companion of ill health to be the lot of the human race. So don't let anyone including yourself say anything different.... You are fearfully and wonderfully made!

Second, though our bodies are amazing and to be celebrated the scripture describes them as 'jars of clay' in comparison to the treasure that can dwell within which is described as an 'all-surpassing power' which 'is from God and not from us.' (" Corinthians 4: 7). This treasure of course is the very presence of Jesus that dwells in the believer by His Spirit.

May we all grow in our appreciation of how amazing our bodies are and how incredible it is that an initial taste of the presence of the living God dwells in our beings by His Spirit. And just in case we are tempted to become a little too pleased with ourselves let us remember that 'not to us, Lord, not to us, but to Your Name be the glory' (Psalm 115:1).
