UK's Emergency Alerts system

Emergency Alerts is a UK government system that provides warning and advice in a life-threatening emergency. The government will be running a national test of the Emergency Alerts system at 3pm on Sunday 7 September 2025.

What happens when you get an emergency alert...

Your mobile phone or tablet may:

make a loud siren-like sound, even if it's set on silent or it may vibrate or even read out the alert.

The sound and vibration will last for about 10 seconds.

An alert will include a phone number or a link to the GOV.UK website for more information.

You'll get alerts based on your current location - not where you live or work. You do not need to turn on location services to receive alerts.

What you need to do

When you get an alert, stop what you're doing and follow the instructions in the alert.

Don't panic! It is a test to see how the system works!




