

Jigsaw South East supports children and young people in Surrey and nearby areas of East and West Sussex and Kent through the death of a loved one. They are a small, independent charity, with a vision to ensure that no child or young person faces bereavement alone. The unique service they provide, run by specially trained Support Workers, is tailored to meet the needs of the families they support, whether in person, on the phone or online. Families can access Jigsaw's support when a loved one has a terminal illness or when they are bereaved and in the last year alone, they have supported over 600 children and young people.
