Emergency Phone Alert Test - Sunday 7th September at 3pm. Emergency Alerts is a UK government system that provides warning and advice in a life-threatening emergency. The government does not need to know your phone number or location to send you an alert.

What happens when you get an emergency alert? Your mobile phone or tablet may:

- make a loud siren-like sound, even if it's set on silent
- vibrate
- read out the alert

The sound and vibration will last for about 10 seconds.
