Today's readings are John 6: 25-35 and Deuteronomy 26: 1-11

#### Jen writes...

The reading from Deuteronomy this week talks about praising God and sharing the first fruits as an offering of thanksgiving. I will not be referring specifically to this reading on Sunday, so thought it would be helpful to call out some key messages contained therein. Firstly, it highlights the importance of thanking God for all He provides; the Earth's first fruits and our own fruitfulness from the gifts he gives us perhaps? Secondly, that the gifts and first fruits are for everyone, not just the chosen people. All of us are called to use our gifts, our first fruits, for God's glory and also to give thanks for those gifts. Perhaps this week we can all think about our own fruits which we will offer in sacrifice and thanksgiving to our eternal and loving God.
